Feast on Poetry at the 6th Annual Poesía En Abril Festival
(Poetry Lovers Can Celebrate National Poetry Month Delighting the Senses)

Did you know Chicago is home to the largest international Latino Poetry Festival in the Midwest? To kick off National Poetry month, Contratiempo and DePaul University will present its 6th Annual Poesía en Abril Festival spotlighting local and international award-winning poets. **The festival is free to the general public and takes place April 11 - April 30 at various venues.** According to Executive Director Moira Pujols, "Chicago is the perfect city for a Pan-Latino poetry festival. Having such a confluence of poets gathered here for Poesía en Abril fosters a fascinating dialogue between visiting poets and their counterpart from Chicago, whose backgrounds are as varied as the visiting poets countries' of origin"

The theme of this year's festival is the five senses. Audiences can indulge their senses with a poetic feast merging poetry with visual art, music, hip-hop, multimedia presentations and food to engage audiences. The festival will also feature readings, performance, literary translation panel discussions and a special performance by poets Juan Carlos Mestre (Spain) and Coral Bracho (Mexico).
